Purpose:

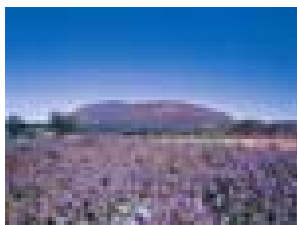
- To foster positive relationships amongst young people
