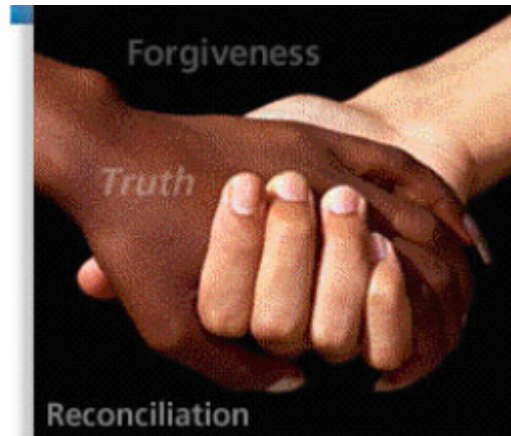

Tourism

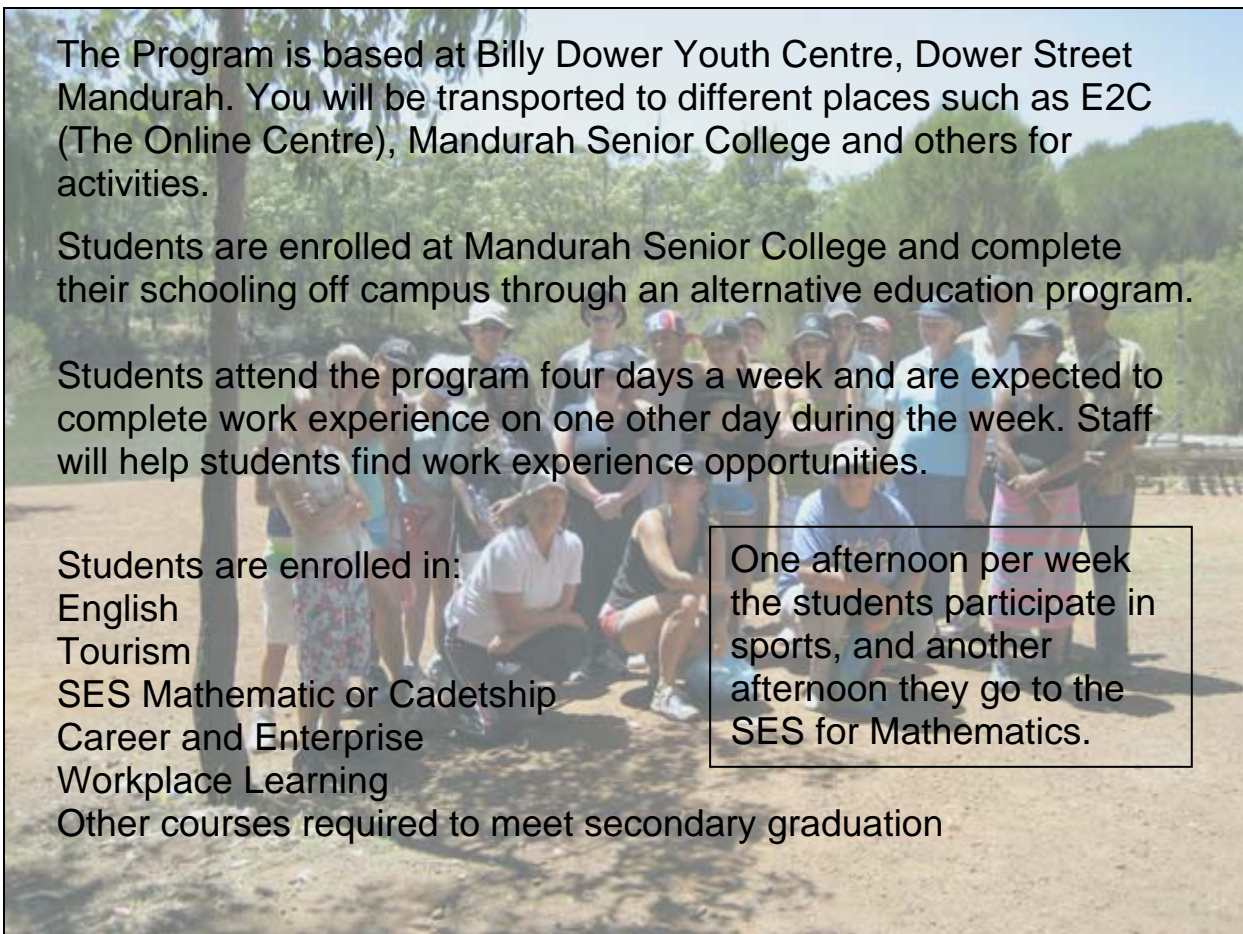
SES Mathematic or Cadetship

The Bilyidar Program is a Mandurah Senior College alternative program which is conducted off-site over a four day period. Entry to the program depends on places being available. All students will be interviewed and meet with program staff before being offered a placement in the program. If there are no places available students will be placed on a waiting list. Participation in the program will be on a trial basis for a period of four weeks, after which an interview will be conducted to review student performance and suitability to the program.
